Principal's Message

We encourage and greatly appreciate parent involvement at Dickinsfield! Parents on our school council provide the "parent voice" critical to the development of our policies. The hot lunch program would not function without dedicated parents ensuring its success. The parent fund-raising organization (PAC) is essential to organizing and chaperoning special fundraising events such as the Casino. The Casino is coming up March 24 and 25, and we need help.... Here's the scoop:

CASINO

Casinos happen every second year, and in a single weekend we usually earn well over the \$50,000 mark! No other fund-raiser comes close to generating this level of money. This money is used for all kinds of educational purchases to benefit the school and the classrooms, items which enhance learning at our school.

We need parents as volunteers at the casino. The jobs are not difficult, and we have a consultant who walks us through each job as it is needed. Volunteers are able to grab some food at the cafe, and visit with some other Dickinsfield volunteers.

We realize that everyone has busy schedules, but we hope that you'll make some time to help with this two-day event. The rules surrounding the casino are pretty strict. They set the expectation of how many volunteers must be present and the time frames for them. If volunteers do not show up on time, the PAC is fined \$1500 and may lose their next casino date,

so if you are volunteering, please also be prepared to find a replacement for yourself if you can't make a shift.


Suggested titles for young children that reinforce Habit 6:
