- b Leader In Me

5.a.b.c.d. Presentation of School Growth Plan

- Paul presented the School Growth Plan. This is a document put together by school administration from data collected from parents, staff and students. Ecole Dickinsfield was high in lots of criteria, however low in PAT test results. This is due to the wildfire evacuation in May. Fort McMurray students were exempt from writing so not all students wrote the tests. The review also showed a lack of parents completing the survey required by Alberta Education. The survey is only sent to parents of Grade 4 students, not the whole school.
- Key suggestions for continued improvement include consistent communication with parents, i.e. updated website. The paper calendar that School and Parent council put out for the 2015/16 school year was appreciated, something like that again would be good.
- To build resiliency in our students, our school counsellor, mentors and family liaison workers have strategies in place to help students cope with trauma. It was suggested that the school counsellor put together a brief synopsis of what they are seeing in kids and how they are preparing for the future (spring time/fire season).

6 Reports

- a. Principal
 - FMPSD received a donation from Samsung; from this, Dickinsfield received 25 Samsung Galaxy View tablets. It works out to 1 per classroom for our school.
 - Coding is becoming bigger at our school. Grades 4-6 participate in entry level coding through tynker.com. Mr. Siad from District Office is coming to our school to do 5 week sessions with students in Grades 5 and 6. It's a little more advanced from tynker.com; students will learn to build computer programs.
 - Along with all this technology, students in Grades 3-6 will participate in Hour of Code. This is a worldwide event where numerous students around the world code at the same time.
- b. Parent Association

- c. Bullying Presentations
 - Paul RCMP have given a cyber-bullying presentation to grade 6, costs for bringing a presentor to Fort McMurray must be considered, all program suggestions must be approved at the district level
