3. Presentation: School Budget presented by Mr. Paul Smith

- FMPSD has an operating budget of \$85 million. \$62 million of that is used towards salaries. \$1.6 million is for contracted services such as physiotherapists, psychologists and occupational therapists. \$2 million is used for utilities. \$1.9 million for transportation and \$1 million for materials. New schools are not part of the operating budget but once they are up and running the operating costs fall under the district.
- Ecole Dickinsfield has a budget of \$3.7 million and 95% of that is spent on salaries. Breakdown is approximately as follows:

\$3.5 million on salaries, benefits and substitute teacher costs

\$73,000 for supplies and equipment

\$27,000 for furniture and equipment

\$25,000 for printing and postage

\$21,000 for equipment rental

\$17,000 for maintenance

\$15,000 for textbooks

\$13,500 for learning commons resources and miscellaneous
